Piano is one of the most foundational skills in musical development. Piano requires focused discipline. It integrates all types of learning styles and coordination. Piano is a foundational building block for nearly all other forms of music. It is also a skill that is a wonderful blessing in many situations and is a powerful tool for personal worship and to help lead others to praise and glorify God who gave us the gift of music to praise Him with.

On the practical side an accompanist can make over \$100 per hour playing for weddings etc. Another example; in the college setting an accompanist who plays for voice and instrumental students can make over \$50 per hour depending on the level of the literature. This is a great way for a college student to bring in extra money without having to work off campus.
